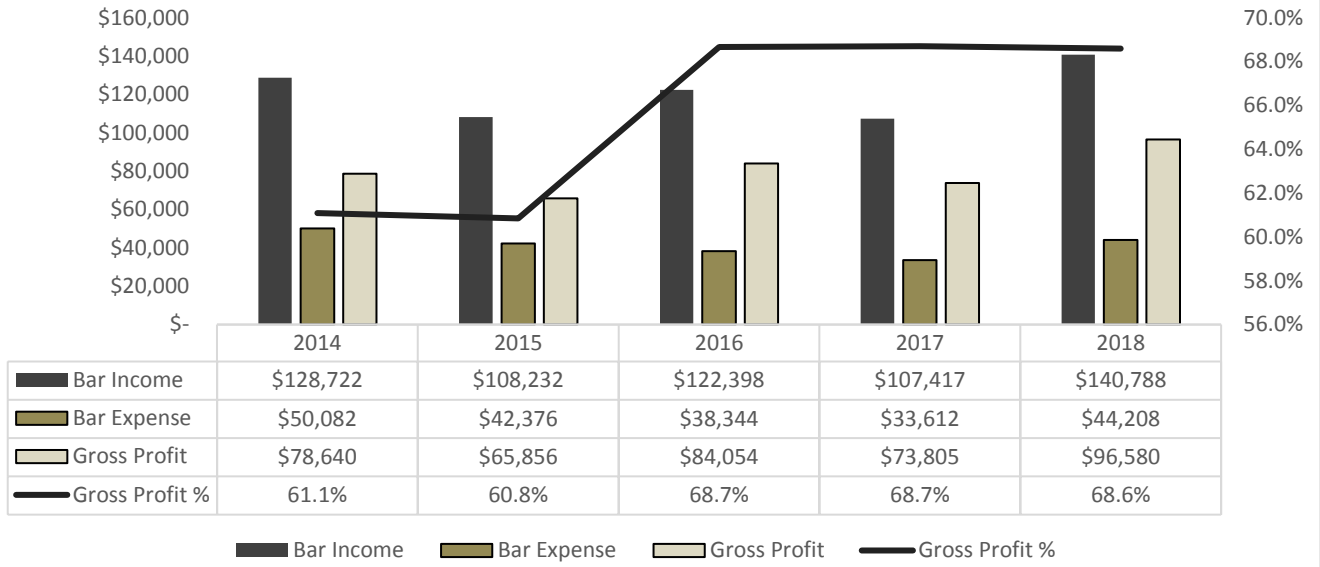

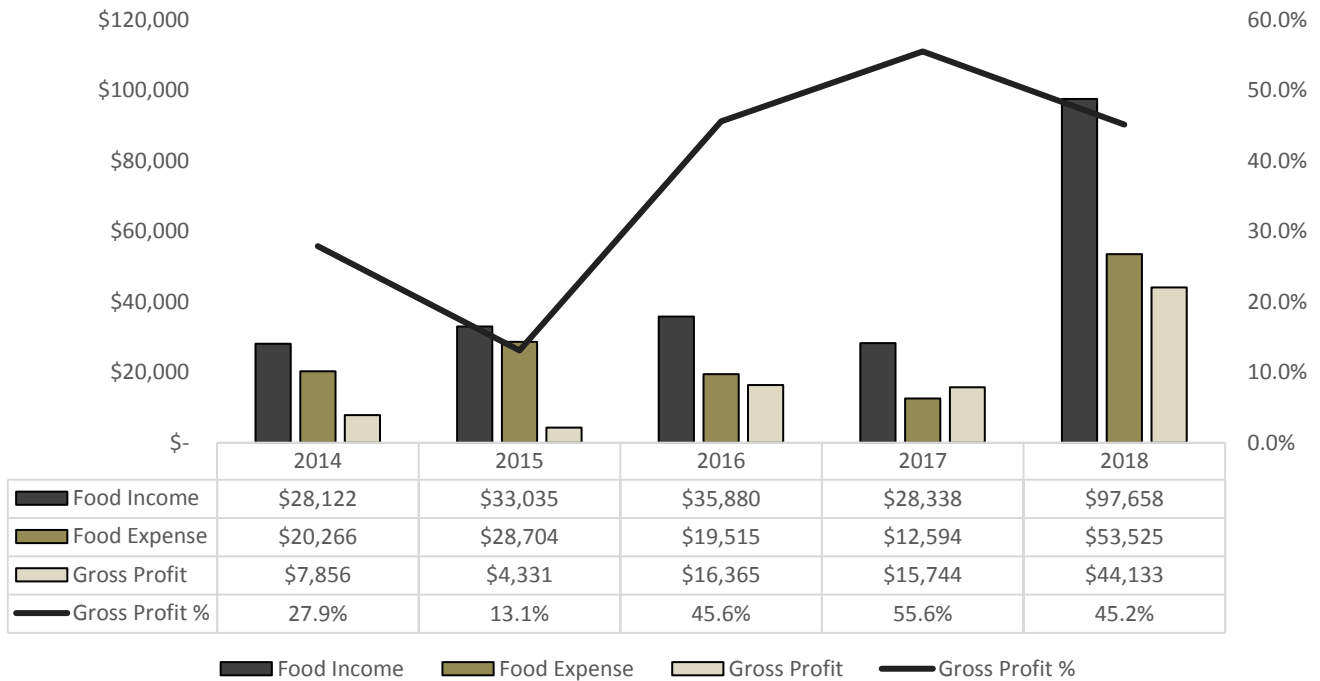

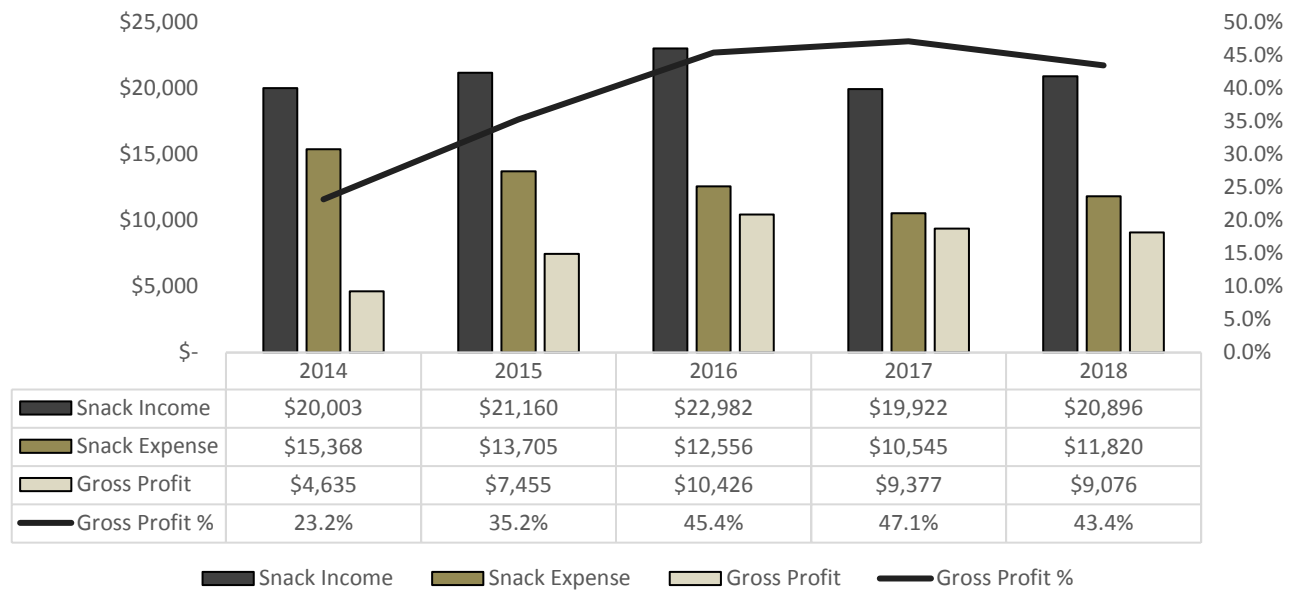
Bar Income



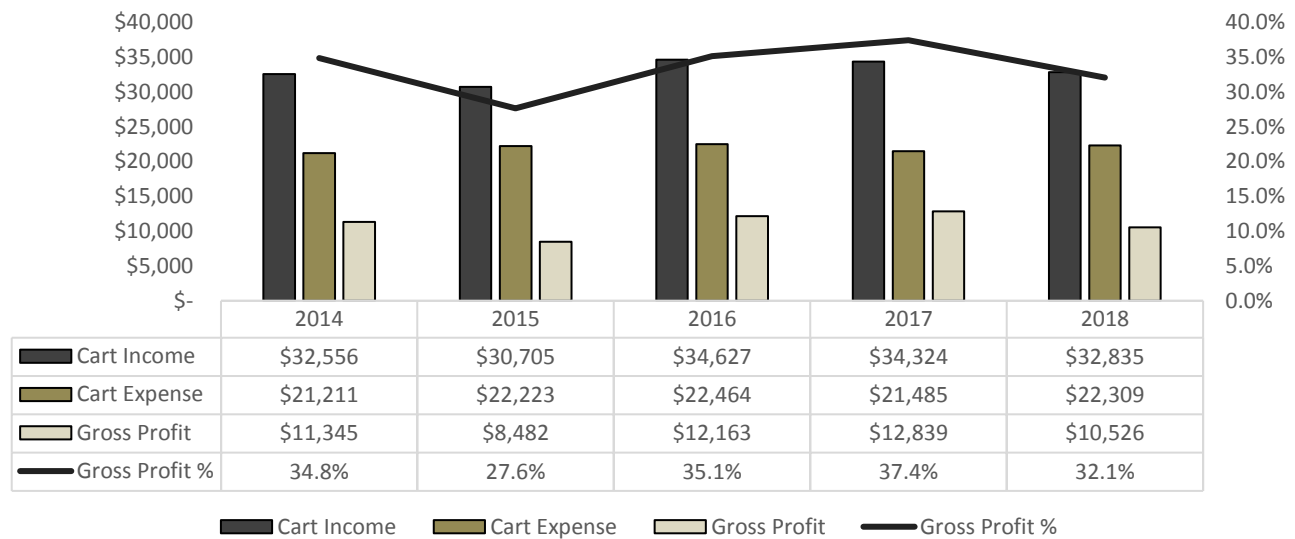
Food Income

Financial Notes for 2018:

Rural Electric Economic Development (REED Loan)

20-year note, 12 years remaining with a fixed interest rate of 3.4% (\$742.64/mo.)

Current Loan Balance: \$92,093

Operating Note at Citizen's State Bank of Tyler

7-year loan at 2.5% taken out in March 2017. (\$1,134.59/mo.)

Current Loan Balance: \$60,852

Fairway Mower Loan at Citizen's State Bank of Tyler

3-year term at 2.5%, taken out in January 2017. (\$1,050/mo. -6 in season payments)

Current Loan Balance: \$8,211

New Till (POS) System Loan

3-year term at 0% interest taken out December 2016. (\$110.61/mo.)

Current Loan Balance: \$1,829

Golf Cart Loan at Citizen's State Bank of Tyler

18-month term at 3%, taken out in October 2018. (\$3,400/mo. -6 in season payments)

Final payment April 2020. Balloon payment was due on the cart lease on October 1, 2018. The board decided to buy out the lease and take out a loan on the \$25,000 balloon payment. We had been making payments of \$3,391.63 from April thru September each year for the last 5 years. When the loan is paid off in April 2020, we will start replacing a percentage of carts on a yearly plan to keep fleet in good working order.

Current Loan Balance: \$25,050

Pump House Loan at Citizen's State Bank of Tyler

3-year term at 3% taken out in October 2018. (\$3,000/mo. -6 in season payments).

Final payment October 2018. The spring of 2018, the pump house was upgraded with variable drive motors. Total cost was approximately \$18,255. This will save on electricity costs for the irrigation system and will cause less irrigation problems and water leaks when the motor starts up, depending on the amount of water draw needed for irrigating.
